Pursuant to Section 607.1003 of the Florida Business Corporation Act, Fuller, Swindle & Holsonback, P.A. adopts these Articles of Amendment:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Fuller, Swindle & Holsonback, P.A.

SECOND: Article I of the corporation's Articles of Incorporation is amended entirely to read as follows:

The name of the corporation is Fuller & Holsonback, P.A.

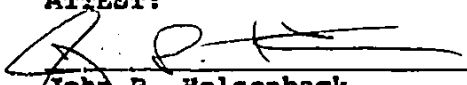
THIRD: The foregoing amendment to Article I was adopted and approved by the board of directors of the corporation by written consent without a meeting on May 8, 1997, and presented to the holders of a majority of the outstanding shares of the common stock of the corporation (the only class of shareholders entitled to vote on the proposed amendment) for its consideration by written consent, with the recommendation that the shareholders approve the proposed amendment. The holders of a majority of the outstanding shares of the common stock of the corporation, which constitutes a sufficient number of votes to approve the amendment, adopted and approved the foregoing amendment to Article I on May 8, 1997, by written consent without a meeting.

FOURTH: The foregoing amendment will become effective when these Articles of Amendment are filed with the Florida Department of State.
