Per our phone conversation on March 20, 2000 regarding the above subject matter, I am returning my signed application with the appropriate fees. I trust that you will be able to clear this matter.

I am asking that the late fees be waived, due to the fact that the fees were paid on time but I failed to sign the appropriate papers. Your office cashed my check and shows that my fees were paid. Below I will try to briefly describe what has happened up until this point.

I was not aware until August 1999 that there was a problem with my corporation. When I found out that you were going to dissolve my corporation I called your office. The woman I spoke to (I didn't get her name) told me to write a letter explaining what had happened and to return the paper work to them. Not wanting to make any more mistakes I asked my Accountant to handle the situation and gave him Power of Attorney so that he could sign any necessary paperwork. I then receive a letter in January 2000 saying that my Accountant is not an Officer therefore he cannot sign the papers. I call your office again and am told to explain in a brief letter what has happened and to send in the fees for 2000, which I did. Now I have received a letter revoking my request and I called and spoke to Tyrone on March 20, 2000 and am here again sending a letter stating what has happened.

In short, two letters from your office never made it to my desk. I was first notified in August 1999 and have been trying to clear up this matter since with no success. Please waive the late charges and reinstate Pasadena Lodge Retirement Center Inc. Please call me if you have any further questions. Thank you for your assistance with this matter.
