The following Articles of Merger are being submitted in accordance with Section 607.1109, Florida Statutes.

Article I - Merging Entity

Article III - Plan of Merger

In addition, the surviving entity has agreed to promptly pay to the dissenting shareholders of an entity that is a party to this merger any amounts, if any, to which they are entitled under Florida Statutes Section 607.1302.

PLAN OF MERGER

The following Plan of Merger, which was adopted and approved by each party to the merger in accordance with Sections 607.1103, 608.4381, and/or 620.202, Florida Statutes, is being submitted in accordance with Section 607.1108, 608.438, and/or 620.201, Florida Statutes.

Article I - Merging Entity

The name, street address of its principal office, jurisdiction and entity type of the merging entity, is as follows:

Article II - Surviving Entity

Article III - Terms and Conditions

The terms and conditions of the merger are as follows:

CHC HOTELS & RESORTS CORP., a Florida corporation (the "Corporation") shall be merged with and into CHC FIOTELS & RESORTS, L.L.C., a Delaware limited liability company (the "LLC") (the "Merger"). All of the shareholders and members of the Corporation and the LLC, respectively, shall combine all of the rights, property and liability of both entities into a single entity under the Merger. Each entity who is a member of the LLC immediately prior to the effective date of the Merger shall, by virtue of the Merger and without any action on the party of any person or entity, cease to be a member of the LLC. Promptly following the execution of this Plan of Merger by the managing director and vice president of the Corporation and the managing director and vice president of the LLC, the managing director and vice president of the LLC shall file Articles of Merger with the Florida Secretary of State.

Article IV - Basis and Manner of Converting Interests

The manner and basis of converting the interests, shares, obligations or other securities of each merged party into the interests, shares, obligations of the survivor, in whole or in part, into cash or other property are as follows:

The interest of each shareholder in the Corporation, represented as shares of stock, shall be converted into an equal percentage interest in the LLC, and such membership

interest shall be reflected in an operating agreement of the LLC, which is to be adopted by the members of the LLC.

The manner and basis of converting rights to acquire interests, shares, obligations or other securities of each merged party into rights to acquire interests, shares, obligations or other securities of the surviving entity, in whole or in part, into cash or other property are as follows:

The right to acquire shares of stock of the Corporation shall be convened into an equal right to acquire membership interest of the LLC and shall be reflected in an operating agreement to be adopted by all the members of the LLC.
