In addition, the action was purportedly taken at a shareholder's meeting for which no proper notice was given and reflects action taken by dissident minority shareholders of both corporations.

The vast majority of the shareholders for both corporations do not wish that either corporation be dissolved and need to immediately reinstate both corporations to keep them active and current.

Following action taken by the majority of the shareholders of Anser, Inc., and Anser Thermal Technologies, Inc., the corporations have authorized the Secretary of both corporations to execute Articles of Revocation of Dissolution, which are enclosed. The enclosures include:
