As indicated in the attached document, my company has been in business since 12/15/1994. After five years in business, our small consulting company is familiar with most official paperwork, including the Annual Report. This year, we did not record receipt of the Annual Report from the Division of Corporations. Frankly, we did not know what to make of it. We did however receive, earlier this month, a notice of reinstatement due to non-filing of our Annual Report. In other words, our business was effectively dissolved by the State of Florida for not filling the required Annual Report that we did not receive this year.

In an attempt to clarify matters, I called your office (850-467-6059) on December 28th and spoke with Andy. I mentioned that the reinstatement fee of \$750.00 represents an unfair burden on our small business and asked for the State's consideration. Andy, who conducted himself in a most professional manner, suggested that I send the regular fee of \$150.00 with a cover letter, detailing the "story". I sincerely hope that the State will extend us consideration, especially in view of our on-time record of prior years. Defaulting on our most basic regulatory obligation simply makes no sense to us, as we have no reason to go out of business.
