ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MICHAEL'S DISTRO, INC.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is MICHAEL'S DISTRO, INC.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

As provided in Florida Statutes, Chapter 607, this corporation shall exist in perpetuity.
