- Article 1 Name. The name of the corporation shall be Martin County Class of 1985, Inc.
- Article 2 Duration. This corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing on the date of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State, State of Florida.
- Article 3 Purpose. This corporation is organized for the purpose of coordinating class reunions for the class graduated June 7, 1985 at the Martin County High School. In fact, this corporation shall be empowered to transact any of all lawful business for which corporations may be formed under Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, as it now may exist, or may later be amended.
