**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article 1. Name and Address

The name of the Corporation is: Marine Service Connection, Inc. The principal office, or the mailing address of the Corporation is: 4701 95th Street North, Saint Petersburg, Florida 33708.

Article 2. Duration

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

Article 3. Purpose

The general purposes for which the Corporation is organized are the following:

- A. To engage in and transact any lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporation Act. No other purpose limits this general purpose in any way.
- B. To do such other things as are incidental to the purposes of the Corporation or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish them.

The specific purpose for which the Corporation is organized is to render the following services: repair and mechanical work on marine craft; and to own and operate the associated facilities, equipment and real estate to render such services.

Article 4. Shares

The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation is authorized to issue is 100 shares of common stock. Such shares shall be of a single class and shall have a par value of \$0.00 per share.

Article 5. Initial Registered Office and Agent

Article 10. Indemnification




