2002 Annual Report

Revenues reached a record level in 2002, and net income before taxes was \$211,463.05. There was no large transaction or single segment of the business that accounted for this increase. Slipmeter sales, lawyer consulting and lab testing were all active areas of income, with slipmeter sales continuing to be the dominant segment. Fifty-nine slipmeters were sold, an increase of 54% over the prior year. Production of slipmeter parts was continued, and another 96 sets were machined and anodized.

There was continuing progress on the standards front with most of the states having developmental state OSHA plans promulgating regulations for slip resistance on painted structural steel components at least as effective as the FedOSHA specification, and the Army milspec was promulgated without the latency period. Opposition to standardization of the **XL** continued, those with less notoriety. The ballot for revision of ASTM F1679 was withdrawn and arrangements were made to rerun the precision workshop.

Advertising costs continued at about the same as the prior year. The Web site continues to grow in drawing power as the online market matures. Institution of an e-mail newsletter contributes significantly to the Web site traffic and the market presence of the **XL** slipmeter. Editing of the second Edition of *Pedestrian Slip Resistance* was begun, and a decision was made to begin disposing of remainder First Edition copies as gifts to lawyer prospects. Apparent development of the British slipmeter market was a surprise. An additional unit was sold to BAA, and following a business development visit to their facility at Gatwick, the distributor thought there was a prospect for the sale of several more. Another breakthrough came with the sale of the SST Sport Shoe Tester to the International Tennis Federation, though only a deposit was received in 2002, and they purchased an **XL** slipmeter. Other slipmeters were sold in France, Germany and Italy.


The certification program has been successful, with **CXLT** certificates having more than doubled to 116, and more classes are scheduled.

There was more trouble with OLSUSA as an ISP. They went out of business, and after being dark for a couple weeks it was put back up on another server, and the three doorway URLs were dropped, thereby reducing the online cost.

Plans for the New Year are to just improve our market performance and service with the **XL** slipmeter and improve our visibility with lawyer consulting and lab testing clients.
