ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Paradise Company of Amelia, Inc..

ARTICLE II. COMMENCEMENT & DURATION

The commencement of this corporation's existence shall be at the time of the filing of these Articles Of Incorporation by the Secretary of State. This corporation's duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

This corporation is being organized for the purpose of real estate investment permitted under the laws of Florida and the United States Of America.

ARTICLE IV. CAPITAL STOCK

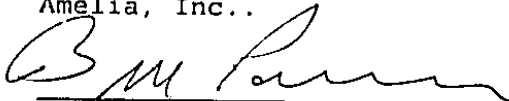
