Dear Reinstatement Reviewer:

I may not like to admit it but as a typically paperwork-overwhelmed small business owner, I am dependent on notices from your department to trigger my appropriate responses and applications. Had I received the notice to file an annual report, I would have done so immediately. But circumstances I had no idea were beyond my control prevented me from receiving the notice.

Imagine my confusion when I received the above-referenced document that seemed to say my corporation had been dissolved. Bewildered, I passed the letter on to my outsourced bookkeeper, who kept it in her "in" box for a month before returning it to me in an envelope marked with a large, red question mark.

After a conversation with an extremely deadpan representative of your office ("Just file the form and send the money."), I'd like to explain why I feel I should be allowed to reinstate Jennifer Howard Inc. without the onerous financial burden harking back to 1998:

1. The notice to file the annual report was sent to a defunct office, apparently for two years, although your office had the correct address. I had made arrangements with the Postal Service and the present occupant of the Mountain Drive office to forward mail, but I suspect that after two years that process was no longer in place.
2. If my intent had been to avoid filing or paying the appropriate fee, why would I have filed the Fictitious Name notice properly and on time? As soon as I understood the nature of the situation, I immediately contacted your office.
