The undersigned does hereby subscribe to, files the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of creating a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is EMILY INK, INC.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business permitted under the laws of Florida.

ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue 500 shares of One (\$1.00) Dollar par value common stock, which shall be designated as All of said stock shall be payable in cash, "Common Shares". property (real or personal) or labor or services in lieu thereof at a just valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors.
