C. To borrow money and contract debts when necessary for the transaction of the business or for the exercise of its corporate rights, privileges and/or franchises, or for any other lawful purpose of its incorporation, to issue bonds, promissory notes, hills for exchange, debenture and other obligations and evidence of indebtsdness payable at a specified time or times, or payable upon the happening of a specified event or events whether by mortgage, piedge or otherwise, or unsecured for money borrowed or in payment for property or acquired or any other lawful object.

# ARTICLE X
