of

We hereby associate to form a corporation under the provisions of Section 607.0202 Florida Statutes. To that end we set forth the following:

- 1. NAME: Baradiga Corporation.
- 2. ADDRESS: The post office address of the principal office of the Corporation, located in the City of Tampa is:

3. SHARES: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have the authority to issue and the par value per share is as follows:
