ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned subscriber to these articles of incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation is

GARY ALAN INDUSTRIES, INC.

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is a broad range of entrepreneurial ventures (including but not restricted to) landscape design and installation, both domestic and commercial, irrigation installation and repair, produce and market the Designer's Landscape show with Gary Alan, and produce commercials and videos:

To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, trade in, deal in and with, goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property, and services of every class, kind and description;

To conduct business in, have one or more offices, in and buy, hold, mortgage, sell, convey, lease, or otherwise dispose of real and personal property, including franchises, patents, copyrights, trademarks, and licenses, in the State of Florida and in all other states and countries;

To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporated property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required;

To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business:

To endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise

To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business,

To endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and while owner of such stock to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock,

To become guarantor or surely for any other person, firm or corporation for any purpose or transaction whatsoever;
