ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CARPET CONCEPTS OF SOUTH FLORIDA, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE

NAME

The name of the corporation is CARPET CONCEPTS OF SOUTH FLORIDA, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

DURATION

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

PURPOSE

The corporation may transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may incorporate under the Florida General Corporation Act.

ARTICLE FOUR

CAPITAL STOCK

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation has authority to issue is one hundred (100), all of which shall be common shares with no par value.
