ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

ARTICLE I- NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be TROPICAL MARINE AND AUTO, SERVICES, INC.

ARTICLE II- DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III- PURPOSES

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all business.
