THE UNDERSIGNED, being competent to contract, does subscribe to these Articles of Incorporation and acts as incorporator for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, and does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be FELCO Farms Corp.

ARTICLE II

MAILING ADDRESS

The mailing address of the corporation shall be 12100 N.W. Highway U.S. 27, Ocala, Florida 34482.

ARTICLE III

NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is:

A. The purchase, sale, breeding, training, ownership and maintenance of livestock, and all activities related thereto.

B. To manufacture, purchase or otherwise acquire, and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, trade in, deal in and with, goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property, and services of every class, kind and description; except that it is not to conduct a banking, safety deposit, trust, insurance, surety, express, railroad, canal, telegraph, telephone or cemetery company, a building and loan association, mutual fire insurance association, cooperative association, fraternal benefit society, state fair or exposition.

C. To conduct business in, have one or more offices in, and buy, hold, mortgage, sell, convey, lease or otherwise dispose of real and personal property, including franchises, patents, copyrights, trademarks and licenses in the State of Florida and in all other states and countries.

D. Contract debt and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidence of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.

E. To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business.

F. To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities, or other evidence of indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other State or government, and while owner of such stock, to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.

G. To engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of this State.
