ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF I.W. OF FLORIDA, INC.

I, the undersigned, hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge, and file these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of becoming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

IDENTIFICATION

The name of this corporation is I.W. OF FLORIDA, INC. and its principal place of business is 2800 Toledo Street, Villa 2, Coral Gables, Florida, 33134.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence which shall commence on the date of the filing of these Articles with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES

The corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV

AUTHORIZED SHARES

The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of 100 Shares of Common Stock of One Cent (\$.01) par value each, all or part of said stock to be issued from time to time as may be determined by the Board of Directors. There shall be no preemptive right granted to the stockholders with respect to the shares of the

corporation. On dissolution or liquidation of the corporation, holders of the stock shall be entitled to distribution ratably as their holdings may appear upon the stock record of the corporation.

ARTICLE V

ARTICLE VI

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- 1. The number of Directors of this corporation shall not be less than one (1) nor more than 7. The By-Laws may provide for the increase or decrease in the number thereof, provided that the number of Directors shall never be less than one (1).

ARTICLE VIII

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

The following additional provisions for the regulation of the business and for the conduct of the affairs of the corporation, and creating, dividing, limiting, and regulating the powers of the corporation, its stockholders, and Directors are hereby adopted as a part of these Articles of Incorporation:


- 1. The Board of Directors from time to time shall determine whether and to what extent, and at what times and places, and under what conditions and regulations, the accounts and books of the corporation, or any of them, shall be opened to the inspection of the stockholders, and no stockholder shall have the right to inspect any account or document of the corporation except as conferred by a statute or authorized by the Board of Directors or by resolution of the stockholders.
- 2. No person shall be required to own, hold, or control stock in the corporation as a condition precedent to holding an office in this corporation.
- 3. Except as otherwise provided by law, the Directors may prescribe a method or methods for replacement of lost certificates, and may prescribe reasonable conditions by way of security upon the issuance of new certificates therefor.
- 4. This corporation shall indemnify any officer or Director, and any former officer or Director, to the full extent

provided by law. This corporation may provide such indemnification, or a portion thereof, through the purchase of insurance.

5. The power to adopt, alter, and repeal By-Laws shall be in the Board of Directors of the corporation or in the stockholders; By-Laws adopted by the Board of Directors may be altered or repealed by the stockholder and vice versa, except that the stockholders may prescribe in any By-Law made by them that such By-Law shall not be altered, amended, or repealed by the Board of Directors.
