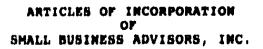

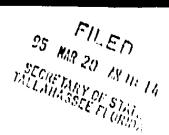

ARTICLE 1. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be SMALL BUSINESS ADVISORS, INC.

ARTICLE II. COMMENCEMENT & DURATION

The commencement of this corporation's existence shall be at the time of the filing of these Articles Of Incorporation by the Department of State of Florida. This corporation's duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE
