**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of Customized Office Cleaning, Inc. under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME


ARTICLE IX - BYLAWS
