ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The Undersigned hereby execute(s) and acknowledge(s) these Articles of a Incorporation in order to organize and incorporate a business for profit under the corporate name stated in ARTICLE IX.

ARTICLE 1 - PURPOSE(S)

The Corporation may engage in the business or profession stated in ARTICLE IX and in any other transaction or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of this State.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The duration of this Corporation shall be perpetual. Corporate existence shall commence at the time stated in ARTICLE IX, provided that all of the requirements of law are met.

ARTICLE III - REGISTERED OFFICE - AGENT

- 7 To purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of and otherwise sue and deal in and with, shares or other interests in, or obligations of, other domestic or foreign corporations, associations, partnerships or individuals or direct or indirect obligations of the United States or of any government, state, territory, governmental district or municipality or of any instrumentality thereof.
- 8 To make contract and guarantees and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the Corporation may determine, issue its notes, bonds, and other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage or pledge of all or any of its property, franchises, and income.
