

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PAGING USA, INC.



The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

EFFECTIVE DATE

Name

MAR 2 8 1995

The name of this corporation is Paging USA, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Duration

This corporation shall exist perpetually, commencing on March 28, 1995.

ARTICLE III

Nature of Business

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transaction of any or all lawful business.

ARTICLE IV

Capital Stock

This corporation is authorized to issue five hundred (500) shares of \$1.00 par value common stock, which shall be designated "Common Shares."
