



We will go along with the dissolution as the company's gross sales are far less than a salesman's yearly net earnings!

I am working hard at inputting all the invoices and such so that I can make my tax return for 1995, which will show a loss or break even at best. I beg for a little more time. Meanwhile, I have taken the " Inc." off of my letterhead.
