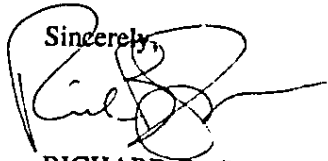

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a Corporation for Profit under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

Article I - Name

The name of the Corporation is A.I.N., INC.

Article II - Principal Office

The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation is 1007 N. Northlake Drive, Florida 33019. The Board of Directors of the Corporation may from time to time move its principal office in the State of Florida to any other place in this State.

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence unless dissolved pursuant to law.

Article IV - Nature of Business

The Corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States or the State of Florida.

Article V - Capital Stock

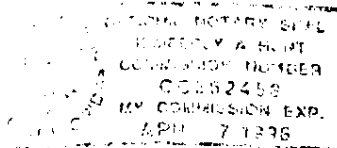
