ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation is a natural person competent to contract and hereby form a professional service corporation for profit under Chapter 621 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE 1 - NAME

The name of the corporation is ALISON K. TOMLINSON, D.P.M., P.A.

ARTICLE 2 - PURPOSE OF BUSINESS

The Corporation shall engage in the practice of podiatric surgery.

<u>ARTICLE 3 - PRINCIPAL OFFICE</u>

ARTICLE 4 - INCORPORATOR

ARTICLE 5 - PRESIDENT

The initial President of the Corporation shall be Alison K. Tomlinson whose address shall be the same as the principal office of the Corporation.

ARTICLE 6 - CORPORATE CAPITALIZATION

- 6.1 The maximum number of shares that this Corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (7,500) shares of common stock, each share having the par value of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00).
