ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR C.A.C. CARPENTRY CORPORATION

The undersigned hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name and principal address of the corporation shall be:

C.A.C. CARPENTRY CORPORATION 1432 South Lakeside Dr., #10 Lake Worth, Florida, 33460

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business.

ARTICLE III - STATED CAPITAL

The corporation is authorized to issue 5,000 shares of common stock having \$0.01 (one cent) par value per share.

Each outstanding share, regardless of class, shall be entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote at a meeting of the shareholders.

The shares of stock may be issued for such consideration, having a value not less than the par value of the shares issued therefore, as is to be determined from time to time by the Board of Directors, to be paid, in whole or part, in cash or other property, tangible or intangible, or labor or services actually performed for the corporation.
