ARTICLES
OF INCORPORATION

OF

FRANK L. BIDDE, INC.

The undersigned, above named, to these Articles of Incorporation, natural persons competent to contract, hereby form a corporation for profit under the Laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is FRANK L. BIDDE, INC.

ARTICLE II - NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general character or nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is as follows:

- (a) To acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise, lands and interest in lands, and to own, hold, improve, develop and manage any real estate so acquired, and to erect, or cause to be erected, on any lands owned, held or occupied, and to encumber or dispose of any lands, or interest in lands, and any buildings or other structures, at any time owned or held by the corporation, to buy, sell, mortgage, exchange, lease, hold for investment or otherwise, use and operate, real estate of all kinds, improved or unimproved, or any right or interest therein.
- (b) To acquire, by purchase, lease, manufacture or otherwise, any personal property deemed necessary or useful in the equipment, furnishing, improvement, development or management of any property, real or personal, at any time owned, held or occupied by the corporation, and to invest, trade, lease, rent, encumber or dispose of any personal property at any time owned or held by the corporation.
- (c) To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and to execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.
- (d) To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business.
- (e) To become a partner with any person or persons, corporation, or any other business entity and engage in the same or other character of business.

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(d) To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, negotiate, pledge or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of capital stock, or any bond, debenture, or other evidences of indebtedness, or to let by any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and who is owner of such stock, to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock;

(e) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts, and agreements of every kind, for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any firm, association or corporation, or individual to constitute the same;

(f) To carry on and/or all of the operations and business, and to conduct the same within the State of Florida or elsewhere, without restriction as to place or amount; and to have, use, exercise and enjoy all of the general powers of like corporations;

(g) To do any or all of the things herein set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, and in any part of the world as principals, agents, contractors or otherwise, alone or in company with others, and to do and perform all such things and acts as may be necessary, profitable, or expedient in carrying on any of the businesses or acts above named.

The intention is that none of the objects and powers as hereinabove set forth, except where otherwise specified in this Article, shall be in anywise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other objects, powers, or clauses of this Article or any other Articles; but that the objects and powers specified in each of the clauses in this Article shall be regarded as independent objects and powers.

ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock which this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is 7,000 shares of common stock, each share having a par value of \$1.00. Said authorized shares may be divided into voting and non-voting shares before issuance by action of the Board of Directors; provided, however, that in the event such designation is specifically made by the Board of Directors, said stock shall be deemed voting.

Authorized capital stock may be paid for in cash, service or property at a just value to be fixed by the Board of Directors of this corporation at any regular or special meeting.

ARTICLE IV - INITIAL CAPITAL

The amount of the capital with which this corporation shall begin business is \$500.00.

ARTICLE V - TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The natural street address of the principal office of this corporation is to be at 4504 CURRY FORD ROAD, ORLANDO, FL 32812. The Board of Directors may from time to time designate such other address and place for the principal office of this corporation as it may see fit.

ARTICLE VII - DIRECTORS

This corporation will have one director initially. The number of directors may be increased or diminished from time to time by this By-Law, but shall never be less than one.

ARTICLE VIII - INITIAL DIRECTORS
