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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PHARM-DURABLE, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation to be formed under the provisions of the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation, to be filled with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation shall be PHARM-DURABLE, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence, unless sooner terminated according to law. The corporate existence shall commence immediately.

ARTICLE THREE

The general nature of the business and the object and purposes to be transacted and carried on, are to do any and all things hereinafter mentioned, as fully and as to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, viz:

- (a) To engage in the business of durable medical equipment.
- (b) To engage in all types of marketing and promotional activities for the benefit of the corporation.
