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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, being an individual, does hereby act as incorporator in adopting the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of organizing a corporation for profit, pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act.

FIRST: The corporate name for the corporation (hereinafter called the "corporation") is BOCA RATON TOWING, INC.

SECOND: The address, wherever located, of the principal office of the corporation, if known, is 1451 N.W. 1st Court, Boca Raton, Florida 33432.
