The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person, domestic or foreign corporation, partnership, limited partnership or association, competent to contract, heroby associate themselves together to form a corporation under the Laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. - NAME: The name under which this Corporation will conduct its business and be known and recognized is:
FLORIDA VENDING MACHINES, INC.

ARTICLE II. - NATURE OF BUSINESS: The General nature of the business to be transacted by this Corporation shall be:
Own and operated vending machines.

Any and all activities permitted under the Laws of the State of Florida and the United States of America.

ARTICLE III. - CAPITAL STOCK: The maximum number and class of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding any one time are:

40 SHARES \$ 1,000.00 EACH

Stock (including treasury shares) may be paid for by cash or other property, tangible or intangible, or by labor or services actually performed for the corporation. Neither promissory notes nor future services shall constitute payment or part payments for the issuance of shares.
