ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

INTERNET MARKETING SERVICES, INC.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this Corporation is INTERNET MARKETING SERVICES, INC.

ARTICLE II

NATURE OF BUSINESS

This Corporation is being formed for the following purposes: To conduct any and all business activities permitted by the laws of the State of Florida.

To generally have and exercise all powers, rights and privileges necessary and incident to carrying out properly the objects herein mentioned.

To carry on any other lawful business and to do any and everything necessary, suitable, convenient or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any or all of the objects hereinbefore enumerated or incidental to the purposes and powers herein named or for the enhancement of the value of the property of the corporation or which at any times appear conducive thereto or expedient.

ARTICLE III

TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporattion shall have perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida. The date on which corporation existence shall begin is the date on which these Articles of Incorporation are filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV

CAPITAL STOCK

This Corporation is authorized to issue 500 shares of \$1.00 per value common stock, which shall be designated "Common Shares".

ARTICLE V

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

CLASSES OF DIRECTORS

The By-Laws of this Corporation may provide that the Directors be divided into two or more classes whose terms of office shall respectively expire at different times, provided that no such term shall continue longer than three (3) years and provided further that at least one-fourth (1/4) in number of the Directors shall be elected annually.

ARTICLE VIII

This Corporation shall have all of the corporate powers enumerated in the Florida General Corporation Act.

Dividends payable in shares of any class may be paid to the holders of shares of any other class.

ARTICLE XI

INDEMNIFICATION

The foregoing right of indemnification shall not be exclusive of any other rights to which any Directors, officer, employee or agent may be entitled as a matter of law or which he may be lawfully granted.
