ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

CARL J. MECKE, the undersigned, hereby makes, subscribes, acknowledges and files these Articles for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be M & G LAW OFFICES, INC.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the purpose of maintaining law offices and transacting any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, as now exists or may after be amended.

ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK

The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of One Hundred (100) shares of common stock of one (\$1.00) par value, fully paid and non-assessable.

ARTICLE IV - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The initial Registered Office of this corporation shall be located at 5740 Hollywood Boulevard, Suite 300, Hollywood, Florida, and the name of the initial Registered Agent of this corporation and said address shall be CARL J. MECKE.

ARTICLE V - INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

This corporation shall initially have one director: CARL J. MECKE, 5740 Hollywood Boulevard, Suite 300, Hollywood, Florida.

ARTICLE VI - SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The following special provisions shall govern this corporation:

A. The time and place of the annual shareholders' meeting shall be fixed and provided for in the by-laws, and notice of same shall be given in one of the methods provided by law. Any shareholder may waive notice of the time, place and purpose of any meeting either before, at or after such meeting.

B. There shall be a President, Vice-President and Secretary of this corporation, and such assistants as the shareholders may, by resolution determine to be necessary and/or as provided by the by-laws. Any person may hold two or more offices. The shareholders may, at any time, by majority vote at a duly-called and noticed meeting declare any office vacant or remove any officer and elect a successor thereto.

C. The officers may describe a method or methods for replacement of lost certificates and prescribe reasonable conditions by way of security for the issuance of new certificates.

D. No person shall be required to own, hold or control stock in the corporation as a condition precedent to holding an office in this corporation.

E. No contract or other transaction between the corporation and any other corporation, in the absence of fraud shall be affected or invalidated by the fact that any officer or officers of the corporation is a party or parties to or interested in such person or persons, firm or corporation, and each and every person

who may become an officer of this corporation is hereby relieved from any liability that might otherwise exist from thus contracting with the corporation for the benefit of himself or any firm, association or corporation which he may be in anywise interested.

ARTICLE VII- OFFICERS

The officers of the corporation who shall conduct the business of the corporation during the first year of its existence or until their successors are elected and qualified shall be: CARL J. MECKE, 5740 Hollywood Boulevard, Suite 300, Hollywood, Florida - President and Secretary.

ARTICLE VIII - INCORPORATOR

The name and address of the incorporator is CARL J. MECKE, 5740 Hollywood Boulevard, Suite 300, Hollywood, Florida.

ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENT

This corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation in any manner now or hereafter prescribed by law, and all rights conferred on officers and shareholders herein are granted to this reservation.

ARTICLE X - COMMENCEMENT

This corporation shall commence its existence upon the execution of these Articles.

ARTICLE XI - PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal place of business of the corporation shall be 5740 Hollywood Boulevard, Suite 300, Hollywood, Florida.
