

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CALHOUN ELECTRIC SERVICE, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is CALHOUN ELECTRIC SERVICE, INC. The principal office and mailing address of this corporation is 6237 N.W. 1st Street, Margate, Florida 33063.

ARTICLE II

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful business.

ARTICLE IV

1. The maximum number of shares of stock which this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be One Thousand (1,000) shares of common stock having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.



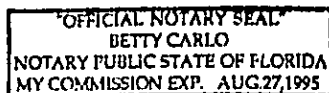


