

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BIG AL'S RECORDS & TAPES 11, INC.

ARTICLE 1 - NAME

The name of this Corporation is Big Al's Records & Tapes 110 Inc.

ARTICLE 11 - DURATION

This Corporation shall have perpetual existance commencing on the date of this filing of these λ rticles with the Department of State.

ARTICLE 111 - PURPOSE

This Corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under Chapter 607, Florida statutes, as now exists or may after be amended.

ARTICLE 1V - CAPITAL STOCK

This Corporation is authorized to issue 1,000 shares of One Dollar (\$1.00) par value common stock which shall be designated as "Common Shares".

ARTICLE V - PRE-EMPTIVE RIGHTS

Every Shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this Corporation, shall have the right to purchase his prorata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.

ARTICLE V1 - CUMULATIVE VOTING

At each election for directors every shareholder entitled to vote in the election shall have the right to cumulate his votes by giving one candidate as many votes as the number of directors to be elected at that time multiplied by the number of his shares, or by distributing the votes on the same principle among any number of the candidates.

ARTICLE V11 - GREATER VOTING REQUIREMENT FOR SHAREHOLDERS WITH RESPECT OF SOME MATTERS

The affirmative vote of a majority of the shares of this Corporation entitled to vote shall be required for the authorization of a merger, consolidation, sale of substantial assets, and amendments.

ARTICLE X111 - AMENDMENT

This Corporation reserves the rapid to amond or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, by a majority vote of the Board of Directors, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE X1V - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address and the mailing address of the initial office of this Corporation is 1020 N. Edgewood Avenue, Jackson-ville, FL 32254, and the name of the initial Registered Agent of this Corporation at that address is Alfred A. Smith. Having been named as Registered Agent and to accept service of process for the above stated Corporation, I hereby accept the appointment as Registered Agent and agree to act in that capacity.

ARTICLE V111 - APPROVAL OF SHAREHOLDERS REQUIRED FOR MERCER

The approval of charcholders of this Corporation to any can of merger shall be required in every case, whether of not that a proval is required by law.

ARTICLE 1X - INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

All corporate powers shall be exercised by and under the authority of, and the business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed under the direction of the board of directors.

This Corporation shall have two Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors. The number of directors may be increased from time to time by the bylaws; however, there shall never be less than one director nor more than ten.
