The undersigned incorporators to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person competent to contract, hereby associate themselves together to form a corporation under the Laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation is Dunlap & Associates, Inc.

ARTICLE II

NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is:

To provide financial advisory services to state, county, municipal, local and other government agencies, as well as corporations wishing to locate within a municipality. These services involve advice regarding tax exempt and taxable debt instruments as well as acting as agent for the competitive bidding of investment proceeds;

To develop and publish music. These services will include entertainment also;

To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers or corporate property, or other

instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required; and

To transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporation Act.
