## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation are natural persons, competent to contract, do hereby form a corporation Toy-product under the laws of the State of Florida. Article 1: the name of the corporation is A CLASS ACT LIMOUSINE SERVICE, INC.

Article II: The purpose or purposes for which this corporation is organized are to engage in any activity or husiness permitted under the laws of the State of Florida and the United States.
