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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SEMINOLE PODIATRY CENTER, P.A.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, natural people competent to contract and legally authorized to practice the profession of Podiatry in the State of Florida, hereby proceed to form a professional corporation in accordance with the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act and the Florida Business Corporation Act, and hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation established as a Florida Professional Association is: Seminole Podiatry Center, P.A.

ARTICLE II. PURPOSE AND NATURE OF BUSINESS

The purpose of the Corporation and the nature of its business is as follows:

To engage in the practice of Podiatric Medicine and to render such services as may be ancillary to the foregoing. The corporation may purchase and own real and personal property necessary or appropriate for rendering its professional services and may invest its funds in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds, and any other type of investments, all in accordance with the provisions of Florida Statutes Chapter 621.

ARTICLES III. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that the Corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is Ten Thousand (10,000) shares having a par value of \$.01 per share. Such shares shall be of a single class of common stock. Pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 621, none of the shares of the Corporation may be issued to anyone other than an individual who is duly licensed to practice Podiatry in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV. DURATION

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V. INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT

If any officer, shareholder, agent or employee of the Corporation who has been rendering professional service to the public for the Corporation becomes legally disqualified to render such professional services within Florida or accepts employment that places restrictions or limitations upon his or her continued rendering of such professional services, then the Corporation shall require him or her to comply with the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act by severing all employment with and financial and stock interests in the Corporation.

ARTICLE XI. AMENDMENT

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law.
