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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

**ARTICLE I. Name**

The name of this corporation is MAY HOME REPAIR, INC.

**ARTICLE II. Duration**

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

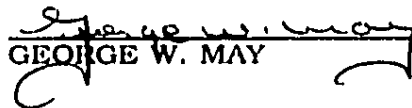

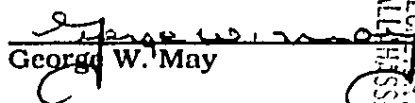
