ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

DAVID K. WITTEK, P.A.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Professional Service Corporation Act of the State of Florida, the undersigned, DAVID K. WITTEK, being an attorney at law and person competent to contract, duly licensed to render services as such under the laws of the State of Florida, do hereby make, organize and form a professional service corporation under the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation is DAVID K. WITTEK, P.A.

ARTICLE II. DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence. The corporation's existence shall commence on the 1st day of July, 1995.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is:

A. To engage in every phase and aspect of the business of practice of law, rendering the same professional services to the public that Attorneys at Law, duly licensed under the laws of the State of Florida, are authorized to render, but such professional services shall be rendered only through officers and employees and agents who are duly licensed under the laws of the State of Florida to practice law therein.

- B. To invest its funds in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds, or any other types of investments and to purchase, encumber and convey real and personal property necessary for the rendering of professional services and to do all and everything necessary and proper for the accomplishment of the purposes and objectives of said corporation.
- C. In addition to the foregoing powers, this corporation shall have all of the general and additional powers and authority granted to professional service corporations under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV. CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue 100 Shares of \$1.00 par value Common Stock.

ARTICLE V. PRE-EMPTIVE RIGHTS

Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any unissued or treasury shares of the corporation, or of any new stock of the same kind, class or series as that which he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro rata share thereof as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares at the price at which it is offered to others.

ARTICLE VI. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE VII. INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The corporation shall have one (1) director initially. The number of directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time by the by-laws but shall never be less than one (1). The name and address of the initial director of this corporation is:

ARTICLE IX. VOTING TRUSTS

No shareholder of the corporation shall enter into a voting trust agreement or any other type of agreement vesting in another person the authority to exercise the voting power of any or all of his shares.

ARTICLE X. CONTRACTS

No contract or other transaction between the corporation and any other corporation shall be affected by the fact that any director of the corporation is interested in, or is a director or officer of, such other corporation, and any director, individually or jointly; y, may be a party to, or may be interested in, any contract or transaction of the corporation or in which the corporation is interested; and no contact or other transaction of the corporation with any person, firm or corporation shall be

affected by the fact that any director of the corporation is a party in any way connected with such person, firm, or corporation and every person who may become a director of the corporation is hereby relieved from any liability that might otherwise exist from contracting with the corporation for the benefit of himself or any firm, association or corporation in which he may be in any way interested.

ARTICLE XI. ADDITIONAL CORPORATE POWERS

In furtherance, and not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida and of the purposes and objects hereinabove stated, this corporation shall have all and singular the following powers:

- A. To enter into, or become a partner in, any arrangement for sharing profits, union of interest, or cooperation, joint venture, or otherwise, with any person, firm or corporation for the purpose of rendering professional legal services.
- B. At its option, to purchase and acquire any or all of its stock owned and held by any such shareholder as should desire to sell, transfer or otherwise dispose of his shares in accordance with the by-laws adopted by the shareholders of the corporation setting forth the terms and conditions of such purchase; provided, however, that the capital of the corporation is not impaired.
- C. To enter into, for the benefit of its employees, one or more of the following: (1) a pension plan; (2) a profit-sharing plan; (3) a stock bonus plan; (4) a deferred compensation plan; (5) a restricted stock opti n plan; cr (6) any other insurance, retirement or incentive compensation plan.

ARTICLE XII. AMENDMENT

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, and any rights conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.
