The under signed hereby agrees to organize a corporation in accordance with Chapter 607, Florida Status (the "Florida General Corporation Act.") as follows:

## ARTICLE I. NAME

## ARTICLE II. CORPORATE EXISTENCE

The existence of the Corporation shall be perpetual commencing upon the filling of these Article of Incorporation unless dissolved according to law

## ARTICLE III. NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business and objects and purposes proposed to be transacted and carried on by this corporation are to do any and all of the things herein mentioned, as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might do, viz.

- 1 Transact any and all lawful business having to do, but not limited to the healthcare industry, including medical services, general sale rentals, repaires, services, etc.;
- 2 Said corporation shall further have powers to
  - Have perpetual succession by its corporate name;
  - Sue and be sued, complain and defend in its corporate name in all actions or proceedings,
  - Have a corporate seal witch may be altered at pleasure, and to use tha same by causing it, or a facsimile there of, to be impressed, affixed, or in any other manner reproduced.

- Purchase, take, receive, lease or otherwise, acquire, own, hold, improve, use, and otherwise dezi in and with real or personal property or any interest therein, wherever, situated.
- Sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, create a security interest in, lease exchange, transfer, and otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets;
- Lend money to, and use its credit to assist, its officers and employees in accordance with Florida Status S607 141.
- Purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own hold, vote, sue, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares or other interest in, or obligations, associations, partherships, or individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States or of any other government, state territory, governmental district, or municipality or of any instrumentality thereof.
- Make contracts and guarantees and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its notes, bonds, and other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage or pledge of all or any of its property, franchise, and income;
- Lend money for its corporate purposes, invest and reinvest its funds, and take and hold real and personal property as security of the payment of funds so loaned or invested,
- Conduct its business, carry on its operations, nd have offices and exercise the powers granted by this act within or without this state,
- Elect or appoint officers and agents of the corporations and define their duties and fix their compensations.
- Make and alter bylaws, not inconsistent with its articles of incorporation or with the laws of this state, for the administrations;
