ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is:

GORDON'S SALES, INC.,

ARTICLE II

NATURE OF CORPORATE BUSINESS

A. To engage in the business or erecting or altering, under contract or otherwise, houses, churches, school houses, office buildings, manufacturing plants, public buildings, and all other buildings of whatever name or nature; to make estimates on and bid for the construction of such buildings and to do every act and thing commonly done by building contractors, to buy and sell building materials and to enter into contracts for the wrecking of buildings.

B. To acquire, by purchase, lease, or otherwise, lands and interests in lands, and to own, hold, improve, develop, and manage any real estate so acquired, and to eract, or cause to be erected, on any real estate so acquired, and to erect or cause to be erected, on any lands owned, held or occupied by the Corporation, buildings or other structures, with their appurtenances, and to manage, operate, lease, rebuild, enlarge, alter or improve any buildings or other structures, now or hereafter erected on any lands so owned, held, or occupied, and to encumber or dispose of any lands or interests in stores, shops, suites, rooms, or part of any buildings or other structures, at any time owned or held by the Corporation.

To acquire, by purchase, lease, manufacture, or otherwise, any personal property deemed necessary or useful in the equipment, furnishing, improvement, development, or management of any property, real or personal, at any time owned, held or occupied by the corporation and to invest, trade, and deal in any personal property deemed beneficial to the Corporation, and to encumber or dispose of any personal property at any time owned or held by the Corporation.

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- C. To engage in the business of providing architectural services. To furnish or supply by contract architectural services requiring application of the science, art, or profession of planning sites and of planning or designing buildings or architectural structures and their related facilities by and under the direct supervision of certificated architects and other licensed personnel, and do any and all things which a corporation of this kind may lawfully do, including, without limitation, consultation, investigation, evaluation, planning, design, preparation or instruments of service such as drawings and specifications, and the supervision of construction insofar as customarily performed by architects.
- D. To purchase, lease, construct, or otherwise acquire and to hold, own, use, maintain, lease, manage, and operate, plants, buildings, mills, factories, warehouses, roads, docks, piers, wharves, stores, shops, boats, ships, barges, sailing vessels, aircraft, rolling stock, and other structures, establishments, and facilities, of every kind, nature, or description, used or useful in the conduct of the business of this corporation, to manufacture, in machinery and appliances for the generation, transmission and utilization of electricity, direct or alternating current machinery, motors, generators, dynamos, transformer, other devices, apparatus, appliances, equipment, and accessories of every otherwise acquire to hold, own, use, develop, maintain, manage, and operate, and to sell, transfer, lease, assign, convey, exchange, or otherwise acquire to hold, own, use, develop, maintain, manage, and operate, and to sell, transfer, lease, assign, convey, exchange, exchange, or otherwise turn to account or dispose of, and generally to deal in and with, personal and real property, tangible and intangible, of every kind and description, wheresoever situated, and any and all rights, concessions, interests, and privileges therein.
- E. To invest and deal with the funds of this Corporation in any manner, and to acquire by purchase or otherwise, the stocks, bonds, notes debentures, and other securities and obligations of any government, state, municipality, corporation, association, or partnership, domestic or foreign and, while owner of any such securities or obligations, to exercise all the rights, powers, and privileges, of ownership, including among other things, the right to vote thereon for any and all purposes.
- F. To carry on, in its own behalf and in behalf of others, whether as agents, consultants, advisers, independent contractors, or otherwise a general investment and management advisory business relating to investments and the operation of business, plants, properties, real and personal, and for the transportation of goods and merchandise of any kind, in the

United States and foreign countries, subject to the applicable laws thereof, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, to act as an advisor and management service corporation and to maintain executive and operating personnel for the purpose of advising and assisting others in all matters pursuant to the foregoing. To manage and to provide management services and negotiate and contract with respect to furnishing of the same for on behalf of any person, firm, or corporation, domestic or foreign; to enter into and carry out agency or joint arrangements with other persons, firms, or corporations engaged in like or similar activities; and generally to exploit the services and objects of the corporation by all lawful means.

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G. To such extent as a corporation organized under the Business Corporation Act of the State of Florida may now or either alone or in connection with other corporations, firms or individuals, all and everything necessary, suitable, convenient accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any or indirectly to promote the interest of this corporation or to enhance the value of its properties, and in general to do any and state or under any act amendatory thereof, supplemental thereto, permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is: 500 shares, all one common class, one dollar (\$1.00) parvalue.

The preemptive right of any shareholder is determined by the ration of the authorized and issued shares of common stock

held by the holder and all shares of common stock currently authorized and issued.


