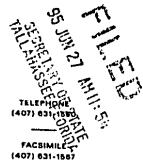

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ISLAND ROCK, INC.



Article I - Name

The name of this corporation is ISLAND ROCK, INC. and its principal office is located at 510 South Tropical Trail, Merritt Island, Florida 32952.

Article II - Duration

This corporation shall exist perpetually. The date of commencement of corporate existence shall be the date these articles are filed with the Secretary of State.

Article III - Purpose

This corporation is organized for the purpose of engaging in any business activity permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

Article IV - Capital Stock

This corporation is authorized to issue 5,000 shares of \$1.00 par value common stock.

Article V - Preemptive Rights

Every stockholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation of the same kind, class or series as that which such stockholder already holds, shall have the right to purchase a pro rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.

Article VI - Initial Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the initial principal office of this corporation is 1970 Michigan Avenue, Building C, Cocoa, Florida 32923.

Article VII Initial Board of Directors

This corporation shall have three (3) directors initially. The number of directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time pursuant to the bylaws, but shall never be less than one. The names and addresses of the initial directors of this corporation are: Terrell Shane Haga, 510 South Tropical Trail, Merritt Island, Florida 32952; Robert Jernel D'Andrea, 510 South Tropical Trail, Merritt Island, Florida 32952; and Judith Marion Haga, 510 South Tropical Trail, Merritt Island, Florida 32952.

Article VIII - Incorporator

Article IX - Bylaws

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal bylaws shall be vested in the stockholders.

Article X - Compensation of Directors

The stockholders of this corporation shall have the exclusive authority to fix the compensation of directors of this corporation.

Article XI - Indemnification

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.

Article XII - Amendment

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these articles of incorporation, or any amendment hereto, and any right conferred upon the stockholders is subject to this reservation.

Article XIII - Acceptance of Registered Agent
