

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

AMERICAN BANCSHARES, INC.



The undersigned, acting as Interporator for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

Article I

The name of the corporation shall be American Bancshares, Inc. and its initial place of business shall be 4702 Cortez Road West in the City of Bradenton, in the County of Manatee, in the State of Florida.

The corporation shall be organized for the purpose of operating as a registered bank holding company under the Bank Holding Company Act of 1956, as amended, and to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under Florida law.

The business and affairs of this Corporation shall be managed and conducted by a Board of not less than five (5) directors who shall be elected annually by the shareholders at their annual meeting to be held during the first four months of each year after the Corporation shall be fully authorized to commence business; provided, however, that if so authorized by a majority of the shareholders by appropriate action of the shareholders at the next preceding annual meeting, a majority of the full Board of Directors may, at any time during the year following the annual meeting of shareholders in which such action has been authorized, increase the number of directors within the limits specified above, and appoint persons to fill the resulting vacancies, provided further, that in any one year not more than two such additional directors shall be authorized pursuant to this provision.
