ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ROCKWOOD LITERARY SERVICES, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is ROCKWOOD LITERARY SERVICES, INC. The principal office and mailing address of this corporation is 3360 S. Osprey Avenue, #202B, Sarasota, Florida 34239.

ARTICLE II

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful business.

ARTICLE IV

1. The maximum number of shares of stock which this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be One Thousand (1000) shares of common stock having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

2. The capital stock may be paid for by the property, labor or services at a just valuation to be fixed by the Incorporator, or by the Director at a meeting called for such purpose, or at the organization meeting.

3. Property, labor or services may also be purchased or paid for with the capital stock at a just valuation of said property, labor or services to be fixed by the Director of the company.

Stocks in other corporations or going businesses may be purchased by the corporation in return for the issuance of its capital stock, and said purchase shall be on such basis and for such consideration and the issuance of so much of the capital stock as the Directors of the company may decide.

ARTICLE V

The amount of capital with which this corporation will begin business shall not be less than Five Hundred and 00/100 (\$500.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE VI

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 3360 So. Osprey Avenue, #202B, Sarasota, Florida 34239, and the name of the initial Registered Agent of this corporation at that address is PATRICIA ROCKWOOD. The Registered Agent and Registered Office may be changed from time to time by filing with the Secretary of State of Florida, a Certificate designating a new Registered Agent and/or new registered office without the necessity of amending these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE VII

The business of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors consisting of not less than one (1) person.

ARTICLE VIII

The number of Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is (1). The number of Directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time by the By-Laws but shall never be less than one (1). The name and address of each of the members of the initial Board of Directors, who unless

otherwise provided by the By-Laws of the corporation, shall hold office for the first year of existence of the corporation or until successors are elected or appointed and have duly qualified are as follows:

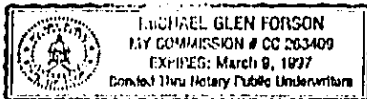
