

CERTIFICATE OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

JPB EQUIPMENT REPAIR, INC.

I, the undersigned, hereby enter into this Certificate of Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of becoming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, by and under the provisions of the statutes of the State providing for the formation, liability, right, privileges and immunities of a corporation for profit.

ARTICLEI

The name of the corporation shall be JPB Equipment Repair, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is as follows:

- A. Repair and maintenance of heavy equipment for commercial use only.
- B. To do repairs and maintenance of heavy equipment for commercial use only to the public at large and whoever else may need repairs and maintenance of heavy equipment for commercial use only that may be deemed to be in the best interest of the corporation.
- C. To acquire by purchase, subscription or otherwise and to hold for the purpose of investment or otherwise and to own, sell or otherwise dispose of and deal in stocks, bonds, mortgages, securities, notes, commercial papers, or other wise deal with other evidence of debt, issued by

any government, state, county or other public authority, or by any one or more persons, firms, corporations, or associations, either foreign or domestic, and whether now or hereafter organized, and while the owner thereof, to execute all of the rights, powers and privileges of ownership; to guarantee or become surety with respect to any obligations of said persons firms, corporations, or associations contained in any of said securities.

- D. To purchase real estate and to build upon or in any manner improve any real estate owned by it.
- E. To purchase, acquire, hold, sell, convey, mortgage, lease, exchange and otherwise deal in real estate and personal property of every kind, nature and description whatsoever.
- F. To buy, sell, trade or deal in any kind of goods, services, wares and merchandise.
- G. To organize or cause to be organized under the laws of the State of Florida, or any other state, district, territory, province or government, a corporation or corporations for the purpose of accomplishing any and all of the objects for which this corporation is organized and to dissolve, wind-up, liquidate, merge or consolidate any such organization or corporation or to cause the same to be dissolved, woundup, liquidated, merged or consolidated.
- H.
