- B. Subject to the provisions and conditions of this Article, the corporation shall have full power and lawful authority to accept property, labor and services in payment for shares of its capital stock in lieu of cash, at a just valuation to be fixed by its Board of Directors.
- C. A director of the corporation may transact business, borrow, lend or otherwise deal or contract with the corporation to the full extent and subject only to the limitations and provisions of the laws of the State of Florida and the laws of the United States.
- D. The corporation shall indemnify each director and officer of the corporation against all or any portion of the liability and expenses reasonably incurred by her or him in connection with or arising out of any action, suit or proceeding in which she or he may be involved, by reason of her or his being or having been an officer or director of the corporation, (whether of not she or he continues to be an officer or director at the time of incurring such expenses), to the full extent permitted by and subject only to the limitations and provisions of the laws of the State of Florida and the laws of the United States.
