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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION CHAMPION TRUCKING, INC.

THE UNDERSIGNED subscriber to these articles of incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

I

The name of this corporation shall be CHAMPION TRUCKING, INC. and the principal place of business shall be 17341 N.W. 6TH STREET, PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA 33029.
