NAME

The name of this corporation is Coyote Co.

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual and shall commence on the date of acknowledgement and subscription of these Articles.



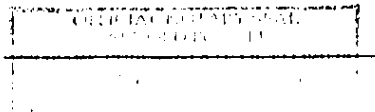


