ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF DOROTHY J. McMICHEN, P.A.

The undersigned subscriber to these articler of inderporation, being duly licensed to practice law under the laws of the State, of The Florida, adopts these articles to form a corporation under the Professional Service Corporation Act, F.S. Chapter 621, and other laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the professional service corporation is Dorothy J. McMichen, P.A.

ARTICLE II. PURPOSES

The professional service corporation is formed to engage in every phase and aspect of the practice of law. In addition, the corporation may invest the funds of the professional service corporation in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds or any other type of investment, and own real and personal property necessary for the rendering of professional services.

ARTICLE III. TERM OF EXISTENCE

The professional service corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date these articles of incorporation are filed with the Department of State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV. CAPITAL STOCK

The capital stock of the professional service corporation shall be seven thousand [7,000] shares of common stock having a par value of One Dollar [\$1.00] per share. None of the shares of the professional service corporation may be issued to anyone other than an individual duly licensed to practice law in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE VIII. RESTRAINT ON ALIENATION OF SHARES

The shareholders of the professional service corporation shall have the power to include in the bylaws, adopted by a majority of the shareholders of the professional service corporation, any regulatory or restrictive provisions regarding the proposed sale, transfer or other disposition of any of the outstanding stock of the professional service corporation by and of its shareholders, or in the event of the death of any of its shareholders. professional service corporation may sell or transfer his/her stock in the corporation except to another individual who is eligible to be a shareholder of the professional service corporation, and the male or transfer may be made only after it has been approved by a shareholder meeting especially called for that purpose. shareholder becomes legally disqualified to practice law in the State of Florida or is elected to a public office or accepts employment that places restrictions or limitations on his/her continuous rendering of such professional services, that shareholder's shares of stock shall immediately become subject to purchase by the professional service corporation in accordance with the bylaws adopted by the shareholders.

ARTICLE IX. AMENDMENT

The corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions in these articles of incorporation in the manner Any right conferred on the shareholders is provided by law. subject to this reservation.
